Candidates must meet the following minimum requirements to be considered qualified to test for the eligibility list:

- Minimum 18 Years Old
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid State Driver's License
- Possess a National Registry Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) or Paramedic Certification. Candidate will be required to obtain an AZ DHS certification.
- NFPA 1001 Firefighter II Equivalent or Arizona Firefighter 1 & 2
- NWCG Firefighter Type 2 (or obtain within one year)
- National Testing Network (NTN)
- CPAT Certification

Selection Process:

- Submit application and resume by established deadline
- Submit certification of “Qualifications and Requirements” listed above
- Successful completion of National Testing Network (NTN) FireTeam entry level test
- Veterans preference points
- Pass a Drug Screening
- Complete Background check
- Proof of Vaccinations
- Pass a Fitness for Duty Physical
